Background

The butyrophilin (BTN) genes are a group of major histocompatibility complex (MHC)-associated genes that encode type I membrane proteins with 2 extracellular immunoglobulin (Ig) domains and an intracellular B30.2 (PRYSPRY) domain. Three subfamilies of human BTN genes are located in the MHC class I region: the single-copy BTN1A1 gene (MIM 601610) and the BTN2 (e.g., BTN2A1; MIM 613590) and BTN3 (e.g., BNT3A1) genes, which have undergone tandem duplication, resulting in 3 copies of each (summary by Smith et al., 2010 [PubMed 20208008]).



Affinity purification

Flow cytometry: 1×10^6 MCF7 cells (Low Expression, left) and U266 cells (right) were surface-stained with ABflo® 594 Rabbit anti-Human BTN3A1/2/3 mAb (A24823,5 μ l/Test, orange line) or ABflo® 594 Rabbit IgG isotype control (A23821,5 μ l/Test, blue line). Non-fluorescently stained cells were used as blank control (red line).

Flow cytometry: 1×10^6 U266 cells were surface-stained with ABflo® 594 Rabbit IgG isotype control (A23821,5 μ l/Test, left) or ABflo® 594 Rabbit anti-Human BTN3A1/2/3 mAb (A24823,5 μ l/Test, right).
