Background

Troponin I (TnI), along with troponin T (TnT) and troponin C (TnC), is one of 3 subunits that form the troponin complex of the thin filaments of striated muscle. Tnl is the inhibitory subunit; blocking actin-myosin interactions and thereby mediating striated muscle relaxation. The Tnl subfamily contains three genes: Tnl-skeletal-fast-twitch, Tnl-skeletalslow-twitch, and Tnl-cardiac. This gene encodes the Tnl-cardiac protein and is exclusively expressed in cardiac muscle tissues. Mutations in this gene cause familial hypertrophic cardiomyopathy type 7 (CMH7) and familial restrictive cardiomyopathy (RCM). Troponin I is useful in making a diagnosis of heart failure, and of ischemic heart disease. An elevated level of troponin is also now used as indicator of acute myocardial injury in patients hospitalized with moderate/severe Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Such elevation has also been associated with higher risk of mortality in cardiovascular disease patients hospitalized due to COVID-19.

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


Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using Cardiac Troponin I (TNNI3) antibody (A6995) at 1:1000 dilution.
