This gene is located in the CST1 cystatin locus and encodes a cysteine proteinase inhibitor found in saliva, tears, urine, and seminal fluid.

Recombinant Human Cystatin-SN/CST1 Protein is produced by HEK293 cells expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence (Trp21-Ser141) of human Cystatin SN/CST1 (Accession #NP_001889.2) fused with a $6 \times$ His tag at the C-terminus.

Bio-Activity

Measured by its ability to inhibit active Cathepsin L cleavage of a fluorogenic peptide substrate Z-LR-AMC. The IC50 value is <11.0 nM.

Storage

Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C for long term.
br>After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20 °C for 3 months, at 2-8 °C for up to 1 week. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Reconstitution


Centrifuge the vial before opening. Reconstitute to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL in sterile distilled water. Avoid votex or vigorously pipetting the protein. For long term storage, it is recommended to add a carrier protein or stablizer (e.g. 0.1% BSA, 5% HSA, 10% FBS or 5% Trehalose), and aliquot the reconstituted protein solution to minimize free-thaw cycles.


